## A

### ADA PARKING

Accessible parking spaces are available first-come, first-served and are in Lot 1. Parking in these spots requires a state-issued handicapped license plate or hangtag. Should all spaces be filled, attendants will direct fans to the next available parking lot with ADA spaces.

## B

### BAGS

The following bag policy applies for the Atlas Cup. One (1) approved bag is allowed per person.

- Clear plastic bag no larger than 12" x 12" x 6".
- Fanny pack or clutch purse no larger than 5" x 7"
- Bags for medical equipment or devices
- Diaper bag

All bags are subject to search.

### BANNERS/FLAGS/SIGNS

USA Lacrosse welcomes banners, signs, and teams' and nations' flags. USA Lacrosse reserve the right to remove any such items at any time. Banners, flags, and/or signs may not be paraded through any part of the venue and may only be displayed between quarters and before or after the game. In



addition, such items must comply with the following requirements (failure to do so being grounds for ejection):

- Do not interfere with the game or other guests' enjoyment of the game.
- Do not obstruct the view of other patrons or cover venue advertising or other signage.
- Do not promote a commercial product or service.
- Do not promote political messages.
- Do not contain inflammatory language as determined by USA Lacrosse management.
- Are not obscene, slanderous, made in bad taste, or otherwise contain language or depictions deemed inappropriate by USA Lacrosse management.
- Are not larger than 3' x 2' in size or have any items affixed to them.
- Are not affixed to the bleacher seats or any other part of the venue.
- Are made of a light, flexible material, such as paper or cloth. Wood, metal and other inflexible materials are strictly prohibited.

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## FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Courteous behavior is expected of all fans. Any fan infringing on another fan's enjoyment of the game is subject to ejection from the venue. USA Lacrosse staff will intervene when necessary to support an environment where fans can enjoy the lacrosse experience free from the following behaviors:

- Foul/abusive language, including offensive language concerning another person's race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, or national origin.
- Betting-related abusive speech and behavior.
- Obscene gestures.
- Intoxication or other signs of impairment related to alcohol consumption.
- Displays of affection not appropriate in a public setting.
- Clothing that is obscene, indecent, inflammatory, or promoting political messages, as determined by USA Lacrosse management.
- Any disruption to the progress of the game by a fan's action or unauthorized persons on the playing field.
- Fans seated in a location other than their ticketed seat.

If anyone is interfering in another fan's enjoyment of the game(s), they are encouraged to visit the USA Lacrosse Information Tent.

Information is in the lobby of USA Lacrosse Headquarters. It will be open from the time gates open until 30 minutes after the final game of the day. Fans can stop by for event information, directions, or general assistance. Staff will be available to help ensure a smooth event experience.

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### LOST AND FOUND

To report or claim a lost item during the event, please stop by the lobby located inside the headquarters. To report or claim a lost item after the event, email [specialevents@usalacrosse.com](mailto:specialevents@usalacrosse.com). USA Lacrosse keeps lost items for 15 days. Items not claimed after 15 days will be donated or disposed of. If guests are looking to retrieve lost items on a non-game day, they must coordinate item pick up. Items may only be picked up during USA Lacrosse business hours of 10 AM to 4 PM, Monday – Friday. Shipping arrangements can be made for guests unable to visit USA Lacrosse to retrieve lost items. USA Lacrosse is not responsible for any items lost on the property.

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## PARKING

### LOT 1 – VIP & ADA Parking

*2 Loveton Circle, Sparks Glencoe, MD*

Reserved for **VIP ticket holders** and **limited ADA parking** only.

### LOT 3 – Stadium and Lawn Seat Ticket Holders

*14550 York Road, Sparks Glencoe, MD*

Shuttle service provided to and from the venue.

**VOLUNTEER PARKING:** LOT 2 (10 Loveton Circle, Sparks Glencoe, MD)

**Important Reminder:** There is **no parking permitted on Loveton Circle**. Vehicles parked along Loveton Circle will be towed at the owner's expense.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

Items not permitted into the venue include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Weapons or fireworks of any kind
- Flags, signs, etc. that do not meet the following – **see Banners/Flags/Signs** Section
- Any missile or projectile-like objects
- Noisemakers – whistles, vuvuzelas, or air horns of any kind
- Laser pointers



- Hard-cased containers or coolers
- Large bags – **see bag policy** under Section B
- Large/Golf Umbrellas
  - Small, handheld umbrellas are permitted into the venue so long as they do not obstruct the view of spectators around you, and it is actively raining.
  - Security and USA Lacrosse staff reserve the right to request your umbrella be taken down or removed at any time.
- Pole and staffs of any kind (metal, plastic or wooden)
- Any outside food and beverages (except special exceptions)
- Camera lenses in excess of eight inches and all tripods/monopods
- Animals (except service animals)
- Frisbees or inflated balls of any kind

Anyone in possession of a prohibited item will be asked to either take the item back to their vehicle or dispose of it.

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### RE-ENTRY POLICY

Single-day Lawn and Stadium Seat ticketholders will receive a stamp to re-enter the venue once they leave. Full event Lawn and Stadium Seat ticketholders will receive a wristband. VIP ticketholders will receive a credential based on single day or full event.

### REFUND POLICY

All ticket sales are final. There will be no ticket refunds and/or ticket exchanges. The event is a rain-or-shine event.

### RESTROOMS

Permanent restrooms are located inside the building. We will have port-a-lets located in and around the field and the Fan Zone.

### RIDESHARE (UBER, LYFT, TAXI)

A designated **Rideshare Drop-Off and Pick-Up location** will be available for spectators using Uber, Lyft, or taxi services. Please follow event signage and staff directions to the designated area for safe and convenient access to and from USA Lacrosse Headquarters. For your safety, always confirm the driver's name, license plate, and vehicle before entering.



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### SEATING

Ticketholders must sit in the section they purchased (Lawn, Stadium, or VIP). Within each section, seating is first-come, first-served. Not sure where to purchase seats? Look at the [TICKETS page](#) on our website for all ticket options.

### SMOKING POLICY

USA Lacrosse Headquarters is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is prohibited anywhere inside the gates of USA Lacrosse, including electronic and smokeless cigarettes, vaping instruments, or any device that mimics the act of smoking.

### STROLLERS

Strollers are permitted inside USA Lacrosse Headquarters.

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### TAILGATING

Tailgating is not permitted on USA Lacrosse's parking lots around the venue.

### TICKETS

You do **not** need to print your ticket. Upon arrival, simply show the **QR code** from your digital ticket on your mobile device at the gate for entry. Digital tickets allow for faster check-in and help reduce waste. Please make sure your phone is charged and the QR code is easily accessible when you arrive.
