Ticketholders will receive a wristband after their ticket is scanned that will allow them to re-enter throughout the day. Spectators will not be granted re-entry without a wristband.

Tickets will be available for purchase at the gate. Credit/debit card only.

Accessing Tickets

If you have purchased your tickets through the EventConnect platform, please follow the steps below to access your tickets in EventConnect.

STEP 1: Log into your EventConnect Account.

STEP 2: Once logged in, click on My Purchases.

STEP 3: Find the Ticket Type you've purchased and then click on View QR Code to the far right. This is the QR Code you'll present at the gate for entry.

Transferring Tickets

If you have purchased your tickets through the EventConnect platform, please follow the steps below to access your tickets in EventConnect.

STEP 1: Log into your **EventConnect Account**.

STEP 2: Once logged in, click on My Purchases.

STEP 3: Find the Ticket Type you've purchased and then click on View QR Code to the far right.

STEP 4: Click on Transfer Item under the Status column and follow the prompt. The individual you have transferred the ticket(s) will receive an email from EventConnect with a new QR Code.

Note: Once the ticket has been transferred, that individual will have access to their QR code from their user homepage. If they have not previously created an EventConnect account, one will be created for them when the ticket is transferred, and they will receive an email prompting them to set up their profile.
