Payment and Game Expectations: All games are 3-person, and each official will be paid \$135 per game. Officials are required to work a minimum of 2 games per day but will not be asked to work more than 4 games per day. (One table official will be added for semi-final and championship games. Table officials will be paid \$100 per game.)

Travel Details and Reimbursement

Officials will receive housing (shared room) along with breakfast, lunch (while working games), and snacks throughout the event. Please see the travel reimbursement structure below.
