

## **PROGRAM MEMBERSHIP COMPLIANCE**

#### 1. IDENTIFY A PROGRAM LEADER

A <u>Program Leader Membership</u> is required for all administrators who access their program's Roster Management portal. Each member program must have at least one Program Leader Member associated with their account. Please contact your Regional Manager to add this role to your membership.

- » Program Leaders must complete the following:
  - » Background Check
  - » Athlete Abuse Prevention training

#### 2. SIGN A MEMBER ORGANIZATION AGREEMENT

The Member Organization Agreement (MOA) is an annual requirement for all program members. By completing it, your organization confirms compliance with USA Lacrosse standards—including athlete safety, coach certification, and roster accuracy. Submitting the MOA keeps your program in good standing and ensures access to full member benefits such as insurance coverage, resources, and regional support. Once submitted, you'll be able to request your Certificate of Insurance (COI).

**New for 2026:** The MOA is now located directly in your program's dashboard. Please contact us if you need help accessing your dashboard or have questions about your program leader designation.

#### 3. MAINTAIN BRONZE LEVEL COACH CERTIFICATION

Bronze Level Certification is the minimum certification required for all coaches before they can coach on the field. Coaches may also choose to pursue Silver or Platinum certification to further enhance their coaching education.

#### 4. UPLOAD SEASONAL ROSTERS & **VALIDATE MEMBERSHIPS**

As a Program Member, you must upload your seasonal rosters via the USA Lacrosse Season Roster Management tool so that all players and coaches are properly registered, protected, and eligible for member benefits. The tool allows you to:

- Check membership status and end date for all players
- Check age verification status for all players
- Monitor coaches' membership, certification and background check status.





To receive the full benefits of membership and maintain eligibility for the insurance program all players, coaches, and at least one Program Leader need to be active USA lacrosse members. This includes full compliance with player age-verification and coach certification standards.

If you use an outside registration system, click HERE to learn more about USA Lacrosse's API integration. Be sure the integration is activated before opening registration so families can't complete sign-up without an active membership. ## **PLAYER REQUIREMENTS**

#### **PLAYER MEMBERSHIP**

Program Membership requires that all players are also active USA Lacrosse members. Clear communication about this helps families understand why membership is required and ensures a smooth start to the season. You can start by sharing this email with your families that highlights the benefits- Welcome Letter to Families.

## Additionally, Program Leaders are encouraged to:

» Share requirements early during and before registration so families have time to renew or update memberships.





- Send brief reminders as the season approaches to resolve inactive, pending, or expiring memberships.
- Be transparent that membership is required for participation, safety standards, and insurance eligibility.

#### **PLAYER AGE VERIFICATION**

Leagues, programs, and event organizers use age verification to support age segmentation policies that support fair play and player safety. Effective July 1, 2025, all players must complete <u>age verification</u> to maintain an active USA Lacrosse membership.

## **COACH REQUIREMENTS**

#### **BRONZE CERTIFICATION**

All coaches must complete minimum <u>Bronze</u>
<u>Level Certification</u> before stepping onto the field. This requirement ensures that every coach has the foundational training needed to create a safe, positive, and developmentally appropriate environment for all athletes. Completing Bronze Certification helps your program:

- » Protect players through standardized safety and risk-management education
- » Maintain compliance with USA Lacrosse full member program standards

- Ensure coaches are eligible under USA Lacrosse insurance requirements



Only coaches who have completed Bronze Certification or higher are eligible for Directors and Officers Liability coverage, which protects individuals during their coaching activities. More on this coverage is in the full insurance guide <u>HERE</u>.
