

## (( System )) How to stop mcafee popups ?

To stop McAfee pop-ups, start by adjusting 1@888@688@5458□ settings directly within the McAfee application. Open McAfee, navigate to **General Settings**, and then **Informational Alerts**. From here, you can control which notifications appear, reducing unnecessary pop-ups. Next, manage system-level notifications in Windows. Go to **Settings > System > Notifications** and either disable notifications from McAfee entirely or customize them to appear only when essential 1@888@688@5458□.
